Fiesta Booth Information

General Guidelines

1. Booths may be set up on Friday from 10:00a.m.-5:30p.m.
2. Booths cannot exceed 10ft. in width and depth. We encourage all booths to be decorated in colors representing the spirit of Fiesta.
3. Booths can be dismantled at either of these two designated times: (a) Saturday at 6:00pm or (b) at the end of the fiesta. You can close your booth early, but do not dismantle until designated times unless you have an okay from the booth chairperson.
4. Each individual booth will be responsible for the collection of their sales tax.
5. Each booth must supply its own trash cans and bags. Food booths must also have a fire extinguisher.
6. All booths are required to clean their own area. No disposal of any type will be allowed on the grounds.
7. No glass containers of any kind will be permitted on Fiesta grounds. All containers must be plastics, paper, or Styrofoam.
8. Booth participants may only bring ice chest for food use. Ice chests must be kept inside the booth. Due to liquor laws, no alcoholic beverages will be allowed in or out of the area.
9. Booth participants may sell only the items approved on their registration form.
10. Booths must be set up no later than 6pm on Friday and 12 noon on Saturday.
11. **No DRINKS** of any type are allowed to be sold by any vendor.
12. No refunds will be given if any of the rules have been violated.

IMMEDIATE REMOVAL CLAUSE: The Zaragoza Society and its Fiesta Managers **DOES NOT ALLOW** vendors to sell any drinks, soft drinks, juices, alcoholic beverages, water of any brand or products that will conflict with Zaragoza Society sales. Vendors violating this request will be asked to leave and will forfeit their booth space and fee. Beer cannot be brought onto the premises because of our beer license.

All vehicles must be out of the area that will be barricaded around the Auditorium before the start of the Fiesta. Parking for the Fiesta will be on the North side of the auditorium next to the show barns behind the Rodeo Arena Area.

Entertainment will be provided throughout the day until the end of the celebration. Other scheduled activities include a BBQ Cook-Off, Mariachi and Ballet Folklorico Performances. We look forward to seeing you at the Goliad County Fair Grounds on May 6th and 7th.

FOOD VENDOR PERMITS The Texas Department of Health requires food vendors to obtain permits. A food vendor will not be allowed to set up without the proper permit. Original permits must be displayed in the vendor's space. Please include a copy of permit with application with your application or bring with you to our event To inquire about food permits, requirements or exceptions, call the Texas Department of Health at 512-834-6626 or visit their website at www.dshs.state.tx.us/fdlicense.
